AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. COTTON

Viz:

- 1 At the end of title III, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. ____ . RESCISSION OF DETERMINATION THAT A COUN-**
- 3 **TRY HAS REPEATEDLY PROVIDED SUPPORT**
- 4 **FOR ACTS OF INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM.**
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 40(f) of the Arms Export
- 6 Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2780(f)) is amended—
- 7 (1) in paragraph (1)—
- 8 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
- 9 (A), by striking “submits to the Speaker of the
- 10 House of Representatives and the chairman of
- 11 the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-

1 ate” and inserting “submits to the Committee
2 on Foreign Relations of the Senate a report
3 justifying the rescission and certifying that”;

4 (B) by striking subparagraphs (A) and (B)
5 and inserting the following new subparagraphs:

6 “(A) there has been a fundamental change
7 in the leadership and policies of the government
8 of the country concerned;

9 “(B) that government has not provided
10 any support for international terrorism during
11 the preceding 24-month period;

12 “(C) that government has provided assur-
13 ances that it will not support acts of inter-
14 national terrorism in the future;

15 “(D) that country is not a country of pro-
16 liferation concern (as such term is defined in
17 section 1055(g)(2) of the National Defense Au-
18 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010 (50 U.S.C.
19 2371(g)(2))); and

20 “(E) that government has provided assur-
21 ances that it will not knowingly support or fi-
22 nance, directly or indirectly, the government of
23 a country described in subsection (d).”;

24 (2) by redesignating paragraph (2) as para-
25 graph (3);

1 (3) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-
2 lowing new paragraph:

3 “(2) Subject to paragraph (3), a rescission
4 under paragraph (1) of a determination under sub-
5 section (d) shall take effect on the date that is 2
6 years after the date of the receipt of a report under
7 paragraph (1) with respect to the rescission.”; and

8 (4) in subparagraph (A) of paragraph (3), as
9 redesignated by paragraph (2) of this subsection—

10 (A) by striking “paragraph (1)(B)” each
11 place it appears and inserting “paragraph (1)”;
12 and

13 (B) by striking “45 days” and inserting “2
14 years”.

15 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
16 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
17 ment of this Act and apply with respect to determinations
18 made by the Secretary of State under section 40(d) of the
19 Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2780(d)) before, on,
20 or after such date of enactment.
