Viz:

1 On page 9, line 3, strike the period and insert the
2 following: “; and

3 (3) a nuclear proliferation assessment state-
4 ment of the Secretary prepared under subsection (c)
5 with respect to the agreement.

6 On page 9, line 11, strike the period and insert the
7 following: “, including an assessment of existing inadequa-
8 cies in the international monitoring and verification sys-
9 tem”.

1 On page 9, strikes lines 22 through 24, and insert
2 the following:

3 (c) NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION ASSESSMENT STATE-
4 MENT.—The Secretary of State shall prepare a nuclear
5 proliferation assessment statement with respect to each
6 agreement described in subsection (a) that—

7 (1) assesses—

8 (A) the consistency of the text of the
9 agreement with the requirements of this Act;

10 (B) whether or not the agreement will be
11 inimical to the common defense and security;
12 and

13 (C) the extent to which the agreement en-
14 sures that activities in which the agreement
15 permits Iran to engage will not be used to fur-
16 ther any military purpose or any purpose relat-
17 ing to nuclear explosives, including for any re-
18 search on or development of any nuclear explo-
19 sive device; and

20 (2) includes a certification of the Secretary that
21 the Secretary has given foremost consideration to
22 whether or not the agreement will take place under
23 conditions that will ensure timely warning to the
24 United States of any diversion of nuclear material
25 well in advance of the time at which Iran could

1 transform the diverted material into a nuclear explo-
2 sive device.

3 (d) FORM OF REPORTS.—Each report under sub-
4 section (b) and each statement under subsection (c) shall
5 be transmitted in unclassified form, but may contain a
6 classified annex.
