5 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-
6 ings:
7 (1) As of the date of the enactment of this Act,
8 18 countries access nuclear energy for peaceful pur-
9 poses without conducting any enrichment or reproc-
essing activities within those countries.
11 (2) The Government of Iran could likewise ac-
12 cess nuclear energy for peaceful purposes without

- conducting any enrichment or reprocessing activities
 within Iran.
- 3 (3) The Government of Iran does not have an 4 absolute or inherent right to enrichment and reproc-5 essing capabilities and technologies under the Treaty 6 on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, done 7 at Washington, London, and Moscow July 1, 1968, 8 and entered into force March 5, 1970 (commonly 9 known as the "Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty"). 10 (b) REQUIREMENT.—Any overall agreement between the United States and United States allies and Iran regarding the nuclear program of Iran shall include a final and verifiable agreement or arrangement with the Govern-14 ment of Iran that will dismantle Iran's nuclear infrastructure, including enrichment and reprocessing capabilities and facilities, the heavy water reactor and production plant at Arak, and any nuclear weapon components and technology, so that the Government of Iran is precluded from a nuclear breakout capability and prevented from pursuing both uranium and plutonium pathways to a nuclear weapon.
